Or, if necessary, WPIC-Beaver County Crisis can help you facilitate  
a hospital admission:*

- Call the **24-hour Crisis Telephone Hotline** (above) at **WPIC-Beaver County Crisis**. The Hotline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- Go to the **Walk-In Center**, also located at **WPIC-Beaver County Crisis** in Rochester. The Center is open between 7am and 10pm, 365 days per year.
- Request a team of clinicians from **Mobile Crisis Services**. They can meet with consumers in their home or in the community, Monday through Friday, from 10am to 6pm.
- Just need to talk to someone? **WARMLINE Peers** are available from 6pm to 9pm, 365 days a year, including holidays and weekends at 724-775-9507 or Toll-Free at 1-877-775-9276.
- The least restrictive care is always preferred. But when further aid is needed, **WPIC-Beaver County Crisis** can also facilitate referrals to community resources and other supports such as transportation to the hospital.
