Shelter

A temporary, safe haven for women and their children seeking safety from domestic violence and/or sexual assault.

- 24 hour Intake
- Case Management
- Counseling & Support Groups
- Basic Necessities
- Follow-up Program

Community Education and Outreach

Trainings and educational programs to students, community groups, and professionals.

Counseling Services

Available to adults, teens and children whose lives have been affected by domestic violence and/or sexual assault. Services include:

- Crisis Counseling
- Individual and Group Counseling
- Parenting Support
- Workshops
- Information & Referral
- Family Events
- On-site crisis intervention at educational facilities

Legal Advocacy

Accompany victims through each stage of law enforcement and court proceedings. Providing crisis counseling, information and support.

- Legal and System Advocacy
- Accompaniment for criminal proceedings and Protection from Abuse Orders

Medical Advocacy

- 24 hour On-site crisis intervention and counseling
- Medical facilities
- Police facilities
