- **Benefits:** The Beacon Health Options Community Benefits Enrollment Specialist Team Lead will discuss Medicaid and provide guidance on the application process. A representative from Mental Health Association will discuss the Representative Payee Program. Please be sure to bring the following documents:
- A photo ID, Social Security Card, and Birth Certificate (if you have)
- Verification of income earned in the past 30 days (such as paystub or award letter showing approval for Social Security/Unemployment benefits)
- Any current health insurance cards
- Any medical bills that are past due and within 90 days of the class you are attending

- **Mental Health Association:** No walk-ins but support is available via phone: 724.775.4165. The following changes are in place so continued support can be offered during this time:
- Phoenix Drop-In Center is closed, but daily reassurance calls are being made to the members.
- Warm line hours are extended 12pm-9pm (mon-fri) and 6pm-9m (sat & sun). In addition to receiving calls, reassurance calls are being made inquiring of wellness and food scarcity. Care packages are being dropped off to individuals in need. 724.775.9507
